Launch Ramp Repair: P and B Paving quote \$19,000 using same pitch; Hagar \$50k. Good for 6/7 years. We have the correct permitting from DEP. Currently \$30k in Waterfront Budget. We'd like to get scheduled ASAP.

Recommendation: Waterfront committee recommends Public Works Director (Ted) Pursue and engage P & B Paving, to recover The Wiscasset Harbor Launch Ramps. 5/0 vote

Town Landing cat walk and float, ok for this season. Our goal is to replace with a smooth walkway and floats.

Pump Out: get advice from our Sewer Dept. Sewer line is blocked. Connecting pump out station to sewer line estimated \$67k. We can install piece-meal: perhaps from the float to the Seawall (by River Shack on Pier).

Ted will pursue an individual electric meter for the units on the Rec Pier, for billing: possibly a dial meter

David Stapp updated us on the Working Group's activity: info on cleaning up over at Birch Point, coordinating with LCRPC's efforts to apply for assistance to continue clean up at Mason Station.

David Also presented the possibility of a floating Schooner museum in the Harbor, as Victory Chimes is for sale. More research into the vision on is on going. This would be a great draw to Wiscasset: The return of schooners.

For winter tie up 2023/24 " Grand Banks" is interested. We need to work on off season docking and scheduling policies, as the harbor is being sought after.

Fuel possibility in the Harbor? A fuel Boat? What would that require?
