Rough Estimate from Prock Marine to remove the sunken vessel from the Harbor \$70k to resurface and drag/tow; \$50k to dismantle and remove.

Dick will pursue with Dennis, possible grant funding or other financing to remove the relic. We agree: 4/0 in favor.

Optimize ATM has been approved...paying electric fee only this season. We will review his electric use for the future billing. 3/0 in favor.

We are reviewing our fees for vendor spots on the Pier possibly changing the basis. There are only 2 30 x 34 spots on Main St Pier; 9 electric outlets.
